

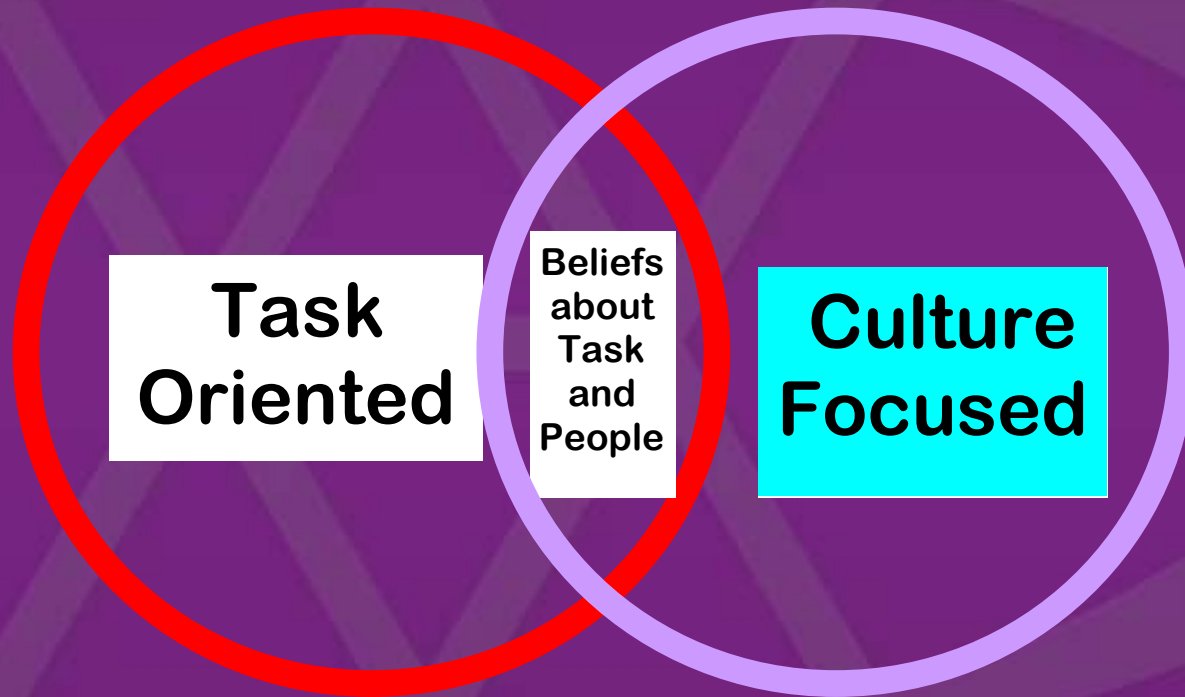

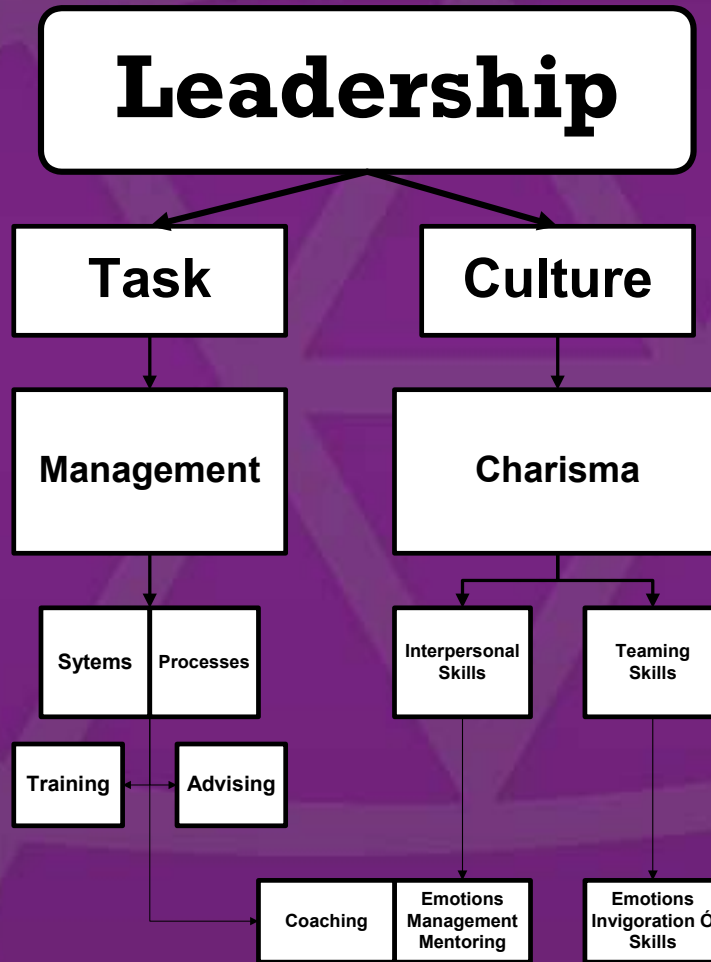


Leadership

This model depicts the difference between Leadership & Management

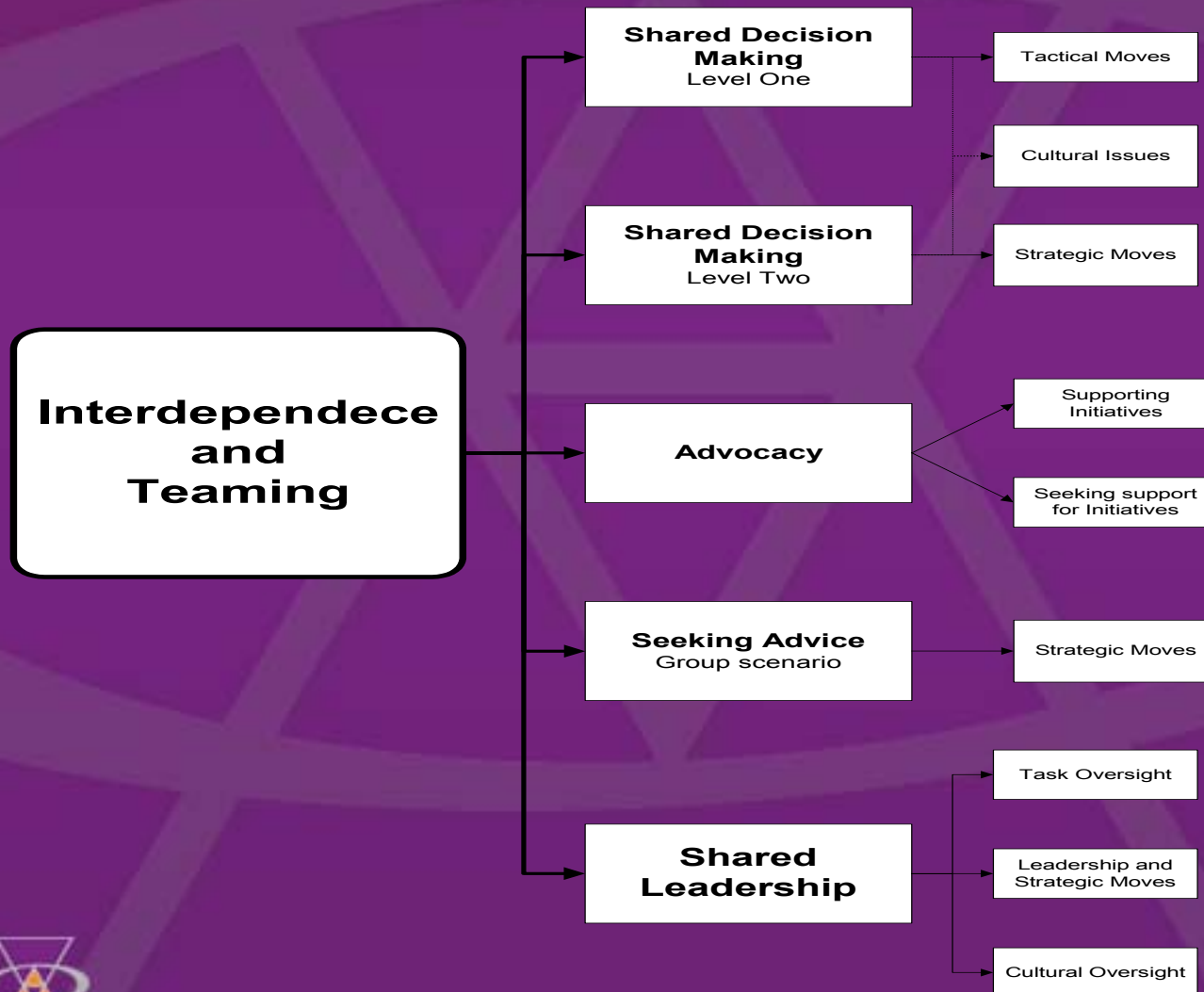
Management is task oriented and involves quality and precision.

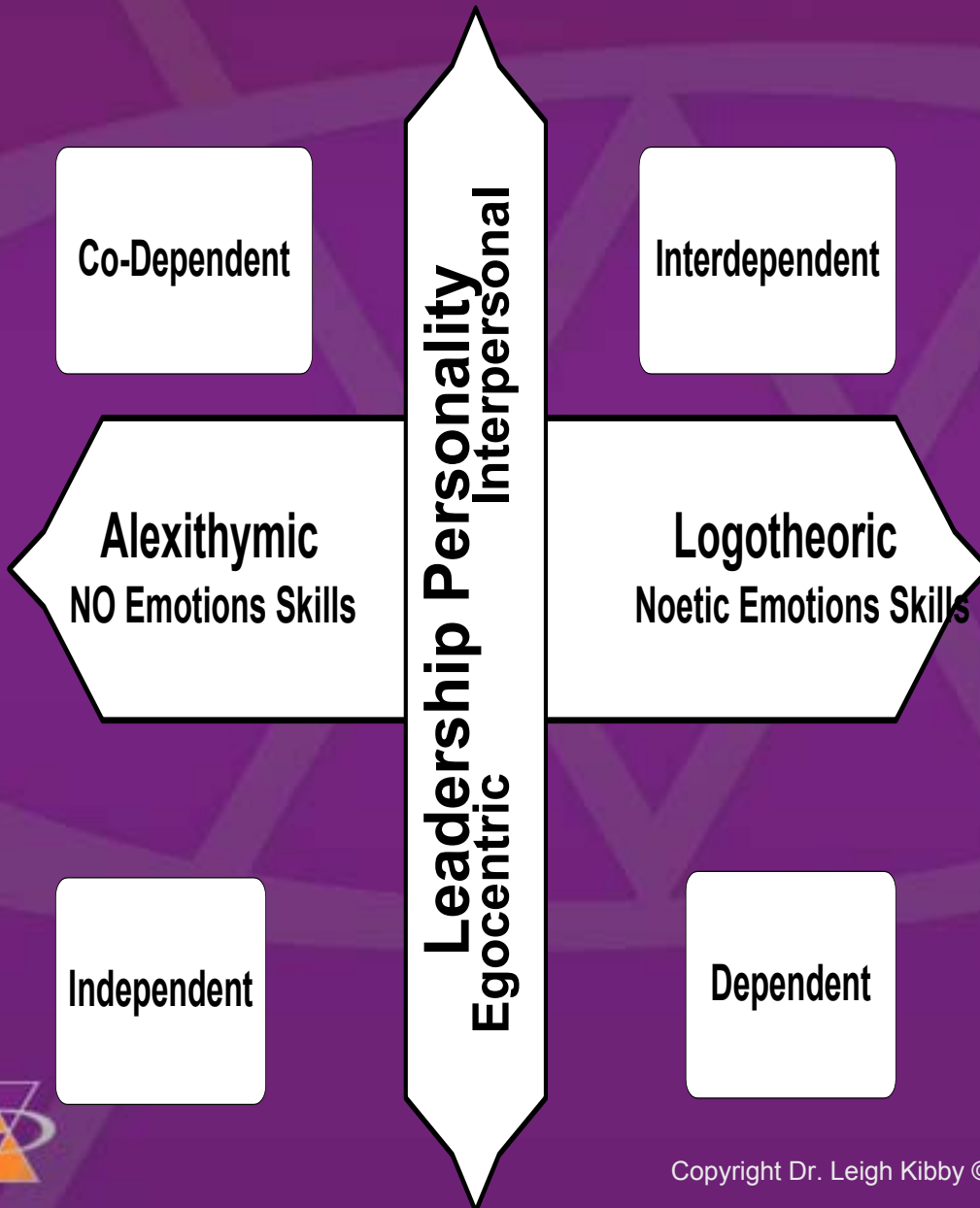
Leaders foster Interdependence and Teaming
